OIS stands for "Office of International Services."

Extended Absences During the Semester and Travel Signatures

As a SLU international student, you are expected to reside in St. Louis during the Fall and Spring semesters. Unfortunately, federal regulations do not allow you to study remotely outside of the United States while maintaining your international student status. If you are considering an extended absence during the Fall, you may need to take a leave of absence (LOA).

You should discuss your plans with your OIS Advisor before making any travel decisions.

Travel Signatures:

If you plan to travel outside of the United States over <u>Winter Break</u> (or any other time), you must request a travel signature.

OIS will begin processing Winter Break travel signature requests <u>after</u> November 11th, 2024.

Travel signature walk-in days, to receive a travel signature in-person, will begin in mid-November and will be located in OIS. Keep an eye out for more information!
